

Little J Red 2013

This is an unprentious, generous wine made from a selection of vineyards in mainly the Agter-Paarl area (part of the Paarl appelation).

Vineyards

The predominant soils are Malmesbury Shale. These soils have a surprisingly good moisture retention capability which allows for dry-land farming in this relatively warm and dry area. The vineyards are a combination of traditional bush-vines and trellised blocks.

Vinification

The grapes were hand-picked and then fermented over 7 days in stainless steel tanks. A small portion (35%) was matured in oak barrels for 12 months and the remainder in stainless steel tanks.

72% Shiraz 14% Cinsault 7% Mourvedre 7% Grenache

Tasting notes

This is a medium-bodied red wine with an expressive nose and a soft, lush mouth-feel.

This is a modern-styled Cape wine that will complement a wide range of foods. Excellent as a sipping red wine, it will also go well with Asian foods, modern fusion cuisine and Italian dishes.
